- If you are registered for STEAM, SFL, or PA you will only choose a CTF B option.
- Inspire - Boys - You will not choose a CTF B - Only a CTF A
- If you are not registered for SFL or STEAM, or PA you will choose both an CTF A and a CTF B option for Term 2.

Course Name	Fee	Description
CTF A: If you are in Inspire - Girls, Sports for Life, STEAM, or Performing Arts - please do not choose from CTF A - please only choose an option from CTF B		
CTF A: Graphic Design	\$0	In this hands-on CTF class, students will explore the fundamentals of graphic design, including color theory, typography, layout, and branding. Building on design basics, students will apply their skills to real-world projects, such as creating ad campaigns, redesigning book covers, or assisting with school posters. This class emphasizes creativity, problem-solving, and digital tools, offering students a chance to bring their ideas to life through impactful visual design. Perfect for aspiring designers looking to build their portfolio and make a difference in their school community!
CTF A: Introduction to WoodWorking	\$25	Students will gain basic knowledge surrounding the use of shop safety, hand-tools, power tools, and woodworking. They will use this introductory course to construct a project made of wood. <i>If you were in woodworking in term 1 - please select another option.</i>
CTF A: ESports: MarioKart	\$10	How do you take a gamer and make them elite? We will look at the multiple aspects needed to go from being a person who plays video games to an elite gamer. We'll focus on components like strategy, fitness, digital citizenship, and emotional intelligence and combine it with other club aspects of a specific game to create an experienced EGamer.
CTF A: Foods: Meats and Meals	\$45	Students will explore many cooking techniques and learn to make a variety of different main course meals.
CTF A: Maker - Seasonal Gifts	\$15	Need a gift for that someone but working on a limited budget? Here's your chance to create meaningful gifts for others or design holiday themed projects! You will work with a specific medium to design and construct. Projects could include, but are not limited to, holiday door wreaths, wood painting/burning, cookie exchange, holiday gnomes, designing holiday outfits and OF COURSE, designing the wrapping paper and bows to go with any gifts!

Course Name	Fee	Description
CTF B: Everyone in grade 8 or 9 will choose a CTF B. Exceptions - If you are in band or if you are in Inspire - Boys - you will not choose a CTF B.		
CTF B: Band (All Year)	\$80 (for the year)	Would you like to learn an instrument, read music and be part of a team? This is your opportunity to try something new or expand on previous skills! Note - If you are registered for band - this is your option for the year. If you did not get a chance to get into band in term 1 - you can choose band in term 2 for the rest of the year.
CTF B: Book to Screen	\$0	Dive into popular or "Booktok" worthy books that have been adapted into movies or TV series, and compare the plot and character development in each. Critically analyze both versions to answer the ultimate question: who did it better?
CTF B - Camper Van Preparation	\$10	Students will have the opportunity to contribute to the project of flipping a van. In this term, students will gut, clean and prepare a utility van to begin the process of flipping it into a camper van.
CTF B: Fashion- Sewing	\$20	Learn how to sew using a hand stitch and using a sewing machine. Students will learn how to follow a pattern and come out with their very own creation!
CTF B: Film Studies	\$0	Learn to have an appreciation of the history of film, directorial choices, and aesthetics.
CTF B: Guitar	\$0	Learn how to play guitar! All skill levels are welcome, and we make accommodations for all music genres and play styles.
CTF B: Maker - Firebirds Inc. (Let's Build a School Business)	\$20	Students will be challenged to create a business plan which will be presented to Ms Bouchard for approval of a new school business start up out of our maker space. Plans will include ideas for merchandise to be created as well as the marketing plan to be used to engage clientele. Students will work in groups to: identify a timeline, brainstorm ideas, develop designs and ultimately create products for the school business that will be available for purchase by clientele. In other words, all business products will be developed and created by students using the available equipment in the Makerspace. Every student will be expected to take on a role in the creation process and the sale process.
CTF B: Foods: Nutrition	\$30	Learn the basics of healthy and balanced eating while making delicious snacks and meals.
